Join us and become an active part of the 1840 living history public display at Pioneer Arizona Living History Museum.

Competitions will include a period Novelty Shoot, Fire Starting, and Hawk & Knife throws. Competitors are required to be in period dress (pre- 1840 including accoutrements). A \$5.00 insurance fee will be charged each shooter - payable prior to competition. Firearms are to be loaded from the pouch with patched round ball only and open iron sights (no optics).

All competitions and primitive camps will be located inside the museum grounds. Admission will be waved for all rendezvous participants in period dress. Water and restroom facilities will be available for shooter's and camper's use.

Traders in period dress are also welcomed with no fees. Please respect the period with appropriate trade and display items.

All campers and traders must be set up before 9:00am or after 5:00pm in order to preserve the authentic feel of the museum.

Modern campsites are located in the west museum parking area and may arrive and leave at any time.

Directions:

From Phoenix: Take I-17 north to Pioneer Road (exit 225), turn left (west) and continue for approximately ½ mile, then follow museum signs.
